Topics addressed by these resources include: planning experiments (PREPARE); designing experiments (the 'EDA'); statistical analysis of the data (InVivoStat); reporting the experimental findings (ARRIVE 2.0); 3Rs compliance; and optimizing research animal welfare.

Good practice in all these and other aspects of preclinical research will help to improve both reproducibility of research findings and their successful translation.
