

EPHAR Paoletti Lifetime Award 2027

Call for Applications

The “Rodolfo Paoletti Award for Excellence in Pharmacology” is presented every 3 years at the EPHAR meeting. The award consists of:

- An honorarium of 2,500€
- An engraved plaque
- Complimentary registration and travel expenses for the winner to attend the EPHAR meeting.
- An invitation to deliver the Paoletti award lecture

Eligibility

The candidate needs to be a member of an EPHAR member Society.

The nomination must be made by an EPHAR Society. Each EPHAR member society can nominate one individual. Self-nominations and posthumous nominations are not accepted.

Members of the Executive Committee (EC) are ineligible to apply for the award during their tenure.

The selected candidate should present at the EPHAR2027 meeting in order to receive his/her award.

Criteria and Selection

The award shall be made on the basis of originality and uniqueness of accomplishments throughout a long career distinguished by sustained, significant contributions to research and/or education in pharmacology, as well as mentoring. The selection of the awardee will be made by the EPHAR EC.

Nomination Materials

The candidate's curriculum vitae in PDF.

A brief biographical summary of the candidate and the importance of their work for use in award winner announcements (in no more than 150 words.)

Ten published articles that are representative of the candidate's work and are considered to be the most important/influential of his/her's contributions. These documents should be provided as a single PDF.

A letter by the President of the nominating society that describes the importance of the candidate's work and his/her mentoring record (in PDF and no more than 1000 words).

Deadline

Nominations for the Paoletti award in European Pharmacology for 2027 are accepted until **October 31st, 2026**.

Applications with all required documents in a **single file** are to be **submitted in electronic form** to the EPHAR Secretary General, Prof. Nezahat Tugba Durlu-Kandilci (e-mail: ndurlu@hacettepe.edu.tr and cc secretariat@ephar.eu).

The outcome is anticipated to be announced by the end of December 2026.
